MARY HAVEN YOUTH CENTER Medical Pass Rules

Medical passes for residents will be approved only when necessary. Unless a resident has been in Mary Haven for over three months, dental, optical and other routine check-ups will not be approved. To request a medical pass, the parent/guardian must provide information regarding appointment time, medical provider, and address of medical provider to the therapist at least two days prior to the scheduled appointment time. If the medical pass is approved, the therapist will prepare a court-order for the resident's release for pass.

he following rules apply:

- 1. Unless otherwise approved, a parent or guardian must transport residents to medical appointments.
- 2. A parent/guardian must supervise residents at all times when they are on a medical pass.
- 3. Residents will be transported directly to and from the destination indicated on the court order and are not permitted to go anywhere else.
- 4. When a resident is on a medical passes, they are to follow all the rules of the Mary Haven program.
- 5. Residents are not permitted to eat, smoke, make telephone calls or have contact with friends or other acquaintances.

Medical passes are granted through an order of the court. Therefore when a resident violates Mary Haven rules while on a medical pass, they are in violation of a court order. Abuse of the medical pass or non-compliance with the above-mentioned rules will result in consequences for the resident.
